 - ii. Nixon not necessarily involved but tried to cover it up
 - iii. Resigned from office (would have been impeached)
 - 1. Gerald Ford becomes president -> pardons Nixon
 - b. Jimmy Carter
 - i. 39th president
 - ii. Saw high levels of inflation
 - iii. Let Iran fall to revolution -> hostage crisis
 - iv. Deal to help NK get nuclear power
- 2. 1980s
 - a. Ronald Reagan elected in 1981
 - i. Good with congress
 - ii. Stuck closest to founding fathers
 - iii. Helped end Cold War
 - b. Berlin Wall
 - i. Announced a "thaw" in border crossings
 - ii. November 9th, 1989 wall came down
 - 1. Soviet Union officially dissolved December, 1991
