## Alexander the Great Continued

- 1. Battle of Granicus River
  - a. 334 B.C.
  - b. Alexander fights Persian forces at Granicus
    - Superior men and spears, with presence of alexander leads to a victory
      Alexander almost dies but saved by Cleitus the Black
      - Alexander almost dies but saved by Cleitus the Black a. Alexander frees Ionia and rules Asia Minor
- 2. Gordium
  - a. Gordian knot
    - i. Ancient greek legend
    - ii. Man who unties knot will be king of all Asia
    - iii. Alexander cuts the knot with his sword
- 3. Battle of Issus
  - a. 333 B.C.
    - b. Darius III of Persia assembles ¼ million soldiers
      - i. Meets Alexander at Issus River
        - 1. Darius flees when Alexander and the Macedonians push through Persian lines
          - a. Leaves, wife, mother and children
            - i. Alexander spares Darius' family
    - c. Alexander refuses offer of an alliance from Darius
      - i. Demands that Darius address him as "Lord of the Continent of Asia"
- 4. Siege at Tyre
  - a. 332 B.C.
  - b. Tyre refuses to surrender, holds for months
  - c. Macedonians construct land bridge to get to city
    - i. Tyrians set it on fire
  - d. Alexander sets up catapults on ships
    - i. Eventually take the city through opening in walls.
- 5. Egypt
  - a. Alexander marches to Egypt and is proclaimed Pharaoh
  - b. Establishes Alexandria
    - i. Lighthouse of Alexandria > one of the 7 ancient wonders of the world
