Fidel Castro, Bay of Pigs, Cuban Missile Crisis

- 1. Fidel Castro
 - a. Attempted to overthrow govt.-failed 1x
 - b. January 1st, 1959 finally successful
 - c. Castro quickly made Cuba a communist country (government owns everything and only 1 political party)
 - d. Got rid of opposition
 - e. Cuba relied on Russia until it collapsed
 - f. Cuba is a 3rd world country-> still communist
 - g. Castro ruled for 50 years, died in 2016
 - i. Many assassination attempts
 - ii. Ruled through 10 U.S. Presidents
- 2. Bay of Pigs-> April 1961
 - a. Attempted U.S. govt. overthrow of Castro
 - b. 1,400 Cuban exiles trained for guerilla warfare
 - c. Landing point->Bay of Pigs
 - i. Southern Cuba so not to suspect U.S.
 - d. Castro found out
 - e. Disaster
 - i. 1,200 were captured, 100 died
 - ii. Eventually released for \$53 million in baby food and medicine.
- 3. Cuban Missile Crisis-> October 1962
 - a. Cuba allows Soviets to start building missile launch sites
 - b. JFK issued a warning in Sept. 1962 to stop.
 - i. Soviets continued to build
 - c. Kennedy orders a guarantine of Cuba
 - i. Demands the dismantling of missile bases
 - ii. Goes on TV and warns the public
 - d. Khrushchev says it is an act of aggression and he continues
 - e. U.S. raises threat to DEFCON 2-war is imminent
 - f. Khrushchev sends 2 letters, JFK ignores the 2nd
 - i. Sends responses -> U.S. would not invade Cuba if Soviets dismantled and removed missiles.
 - g. Robert Kennedy meets with ambassador and agrees to remove missiles from Turkey (has to be kept private)
 - h. October 28th-Khrushchev announces removal of missiles
 - i. Nuclear war averted
