Eisenhower Continued

- 1. Missile Gap
 - a. Perception that Russia was developing an Intercontinental Range Ballistic Missile System (ICBM).
 - b. Gap was false, but fear was present.
- 2. U-2 Incident
 - a. Disproved missile gap
 - b. U-2 spy planes flew over USSR collecting intel
 - c. Russia knew but didn't have tech to stop (for 4 years)
 - d. May 1st, 1960 CIA pilot Francis Gary Powers was shot down
 - i. Russia now had proof, Powers was sentenced to 10 years in prison by Russia.
 - ii. Served 2 years, US and Russia had prisoner swap.
- 3. Yuri Gagarin
 - a. 1st human in space
 - b. Orbited Earth for 89 minutes
 - c. Instant celebrity
- 4. Eisenhower's Farewell Speech
 - a. January 17th, 1961
 - b. Warned Americans of the military-industrial complex
 - i. Don't abuse the military power
 - ii. Don't get to focused on the military
 - c. Also warned about needing to protect the future for "our grandchildren."
