1. Nazi's started with Dachua in 1933
2. Nuremberg Race Laws
 - a. Forced to wear yellow star
 - b. Lost jobs, houses
3. Jews were moved to ghettos in Poland
 - a. Poverty
 - b. Hunger
 - c. Disease
4. Handicap were euthanized
5. Hitler continued to expand
 - a. Need for a "final solution"
6. Jews, Gypsies, Catholics and "misfits" were sent to concentration camps.
7. Heaviest deportations took place in 1942.
8. Warsaw Ghetto Uprising
 - a. 50,000 survivors were sent to camps.
9. 6 million Jews were murdered
 - a. Only Jews were gassed, others died of starvation/disease.
 - b. Josef Mengele ->Angel of Death
 - i. Experimented on prisoners, especially twins
10. Saint Maximilian Kolbe -> offered his life to save another.
11. St. Edith Stein -> one of the smartest women of the 20th century, gassed at Auschwitz.
12. Survivors struggled after war -> many lost their whole family.
 - a. Israel was created for Jewish people.

8. Ghetto: crowded, poor part of a city. Where Jews were forced to live in unhealthy conditions.
9. Holocaust: systematic, state-run execution of Jews OR destruction/murder on a mass scale.
