Korean War Continued

- 1. The End
 - a. General Matthew Ridgeway replaced MacArthur.
 - b. Next 2 years both sides went back and forth, neither getting a definitive advantage.
 - c. China/North Korea had more manpower, but the U.S. had better technology.
 - d. There would be no victory w/o significant loss of life.
- 2. Armistice
 - a. Armistice was finally negotiated and signed on July 27th, 1953
 - b. Did not end the war, the war is still going on since no peace treaty was signed.
 - c. Neither side is willing to admit defeat.
- 3. DMZ Established
 - a. The demiltarized zone -> stip ~160 miles long, 2.5 miles wide
 - i. No military presence inside
 - ii. Most heavily fortified border in the world
 - iii. Roughly follows 38th Parallel
 - iv. Where negotiations occur
- 4. Forgotten War
 - a. Often called the Forgotten War
 - i. Between WWII and Vietnam
