Korean War

- 1. Before the War
 - a. Russia liberated North from Japan
 - b. U.S. liberated South from Japan
 - i. Dividing line was 38th Parallel
 - c. Both sides put governments in place that aligned with their own
 - i. North: Kim II Sung
 - ii. South: Syngman Rhee
 - d. Both leaders claimed the other was illegitimate and they had rights to the other's land.
- 2. Korean War
 - a. North Korea convinced Stalin to help (as long as Soviet troops did not fight US troops)
 - b. June 25th, 1950 North Korea invaded South Korea
 - i. NK forces advanced quickly, < 1 week 75% of the South's army was wiped out. 90% after 1 month
 - 1. No appeasing, people saw this as Hitler invading Poland.
 - ii. The SK forces were pushed to Busan.
 - iii. U.S. and UN forces brought in under General MacArthur.
- 3. Inchon
 - a. General MacArthur attacked and was able to quickly advance
 - i. Retook Seoul shortly after
 - ii. Moved on to North's capital Pyongyang.
 - 1. Truman's orders, but told NOT to engage with Soviet or Chinese forces
 - b. North Korea
 - i. Had convinced China to help, China convinced Soviets to help with air support
 - ii. They pushed back MacArthur's troops.
 - c. General MacArthur
 - i. Requested use of nuclear bombs, was denied
 - ii. Truman ended up firing MacArthur for insubordination on <u>April 11th.</u> <u>1951.</u>
 - iii. After congressional hearings, the public came to see Truman did the right thing.
