 - a. Became president after JFK assassination
 - b. Ended up being dishonest and a bully
- 2. Great Society
 - a. Johnson's welfare platform
 - b. Work to end poverty, reduce crime, abolish inequality and improve the environment
 - c. War on Poverty
 - i. Head Start for children -> at risk kids get help
 - ii. Medicare & Medicaid-> help with medical costs
 - iii. Funds to cities
 - 1. Led to corruption
 - iv. Billions spent to help -> in the end we still have poverty and it has become cyclical
 - v. War on Drugs
 - 1. Increased penalty for possession/trafficking of of harmful drugs
 - 2. Created Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs
 - 3. Passed many acts and laws to help control drug and crime rates
- 3. Aftermath of the Great Society
 - a. Trillions have been spent to get rid of poverty, didn't work
