Post WWII Soviet Union

- 1. Purges & The KGB
 - a. Stalin had multiple purges
 - i. Anyone who was a "threat" could be killed or sent to the gulag
 - 1. Artists, writers, intellectuals, military officers
 - 2. Showing up late for work, not hitting your quota for the day, not working hard enough
 - b. Show Trials
 - i. Trials used to show Russia was "under attack"
 - ii. Never a fair trial, always found guilty
 - iii. Everyone knew it was a sham, but the terror of Stalin and the KGB kept people quiet.
 - c. The NKVD assisted Stalin (precursor to KGB)
 - i. Created their own laws.
- 2. Stalin's End
 - a. Stalin dies -> March 1953
 - b. Nikita Khrushchev took over
 - i. Denounced purges
 - ii. "Thaw" in policies
- 3. Nuclear Power
 - a. 1st test on August 29th, 1949
 - b. Happened sooner than US thought
 - c. 2 strongest world powers now have nuclear weapons.
- 4. Space Race
 - a. Fears of aerial spying and launching of long range nuclear missiles from space.
 - b. Russia beat us
 - i. Sputnik 1 launched October 4th, 1957,
 - 1. 1st man made object into orbit, went until January 1958
 - ii. Sputnik 2 on November 3rd, 1957
 - 1. Laika the dog was on board->died
 - iii. The US did not launch until January 31st, 1958.
 - 1. NASA (National Aeronautics and Space Administration) created shortly after.
 - c. US beats Russia to the moon with 2 men on Apollo 11, July of 1969 -> Ends the Space Race
