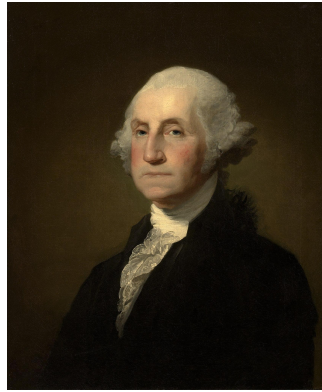


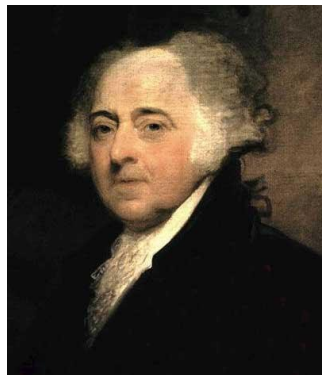

George Washington

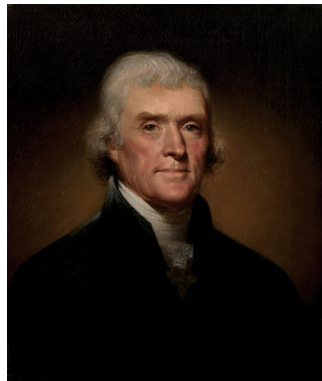
-America's 1st President

John Adams

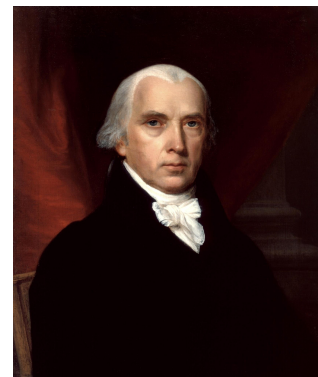
-1797

Papers

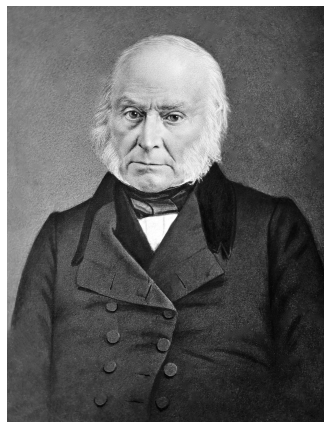
-1809

-1817



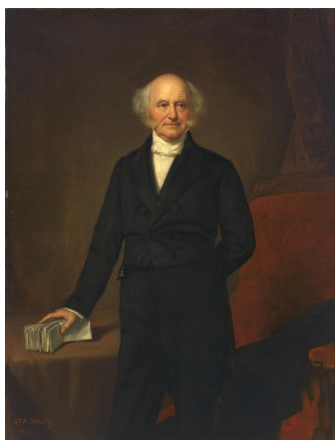
John Quincy Adams

Andrew Jackson

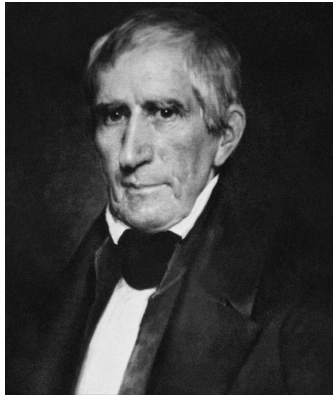
-Wanted to be the direct

Martin Van Buren

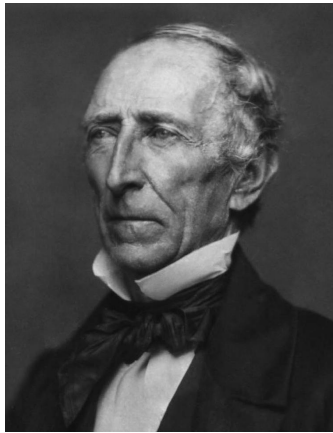
-Saw America's 1st

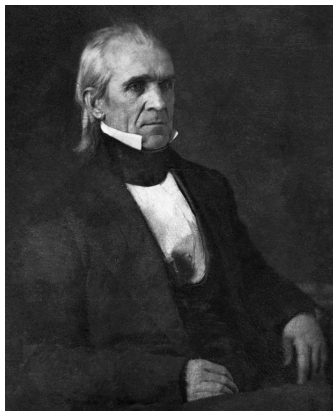
William Harrison

- 1841



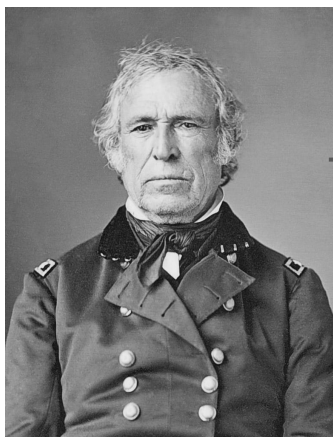
John Tyler

Zachary Taylor

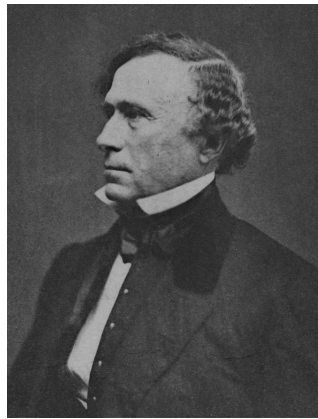
- Almost had the Civil War

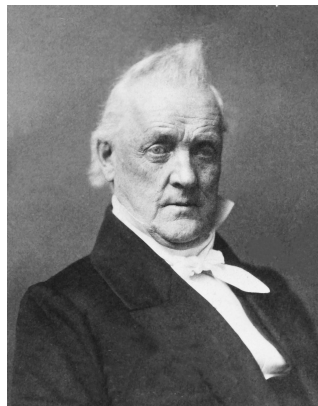
Millard Fillmore

- 1850



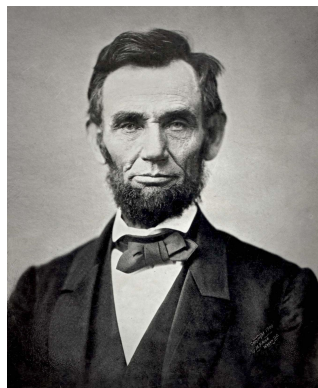
Franklin Pierce

James Buchanan

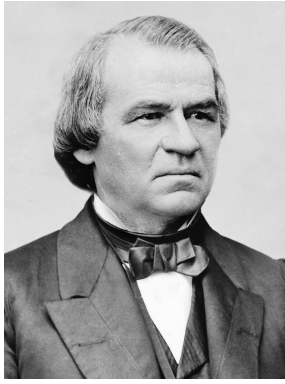
- Only president who was never married

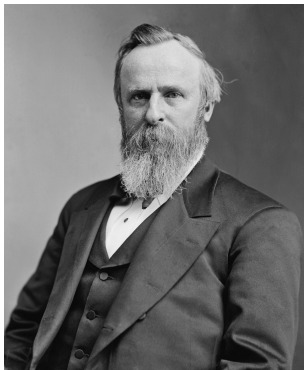
Andrew Johnson

-1865



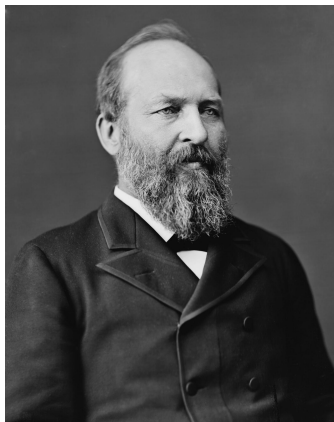
Ulysses S. Grant

Rutherford B. Hayes

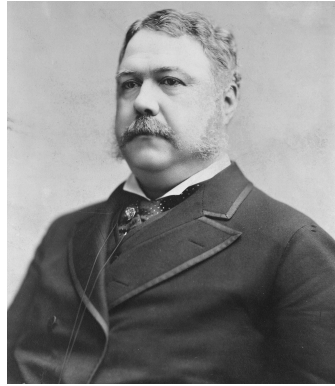
-Elected because of

James A. Garfield

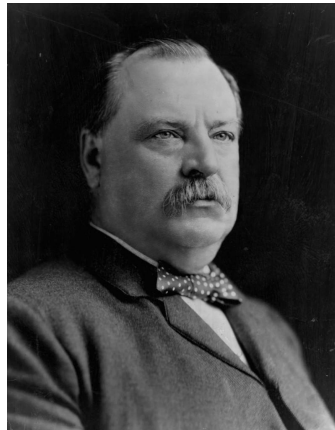
-Shot by an angry attorney

-1881



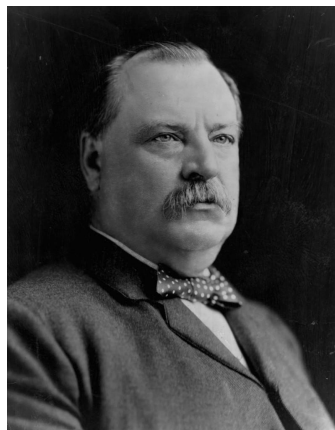
Grover Cleveland

Grover Cleveland

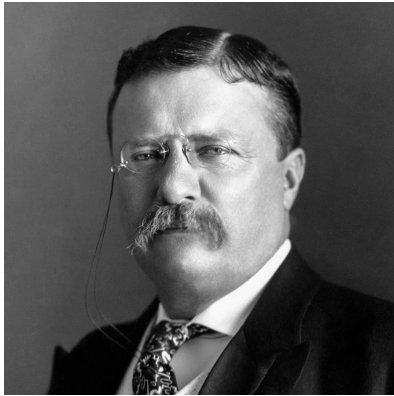
-1st president to serve 2

-1897



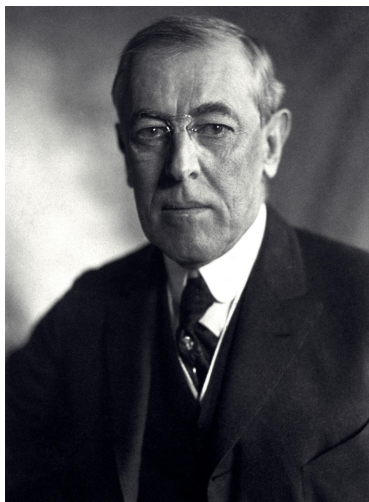
Theodore Roosevelt

William Howard Taft

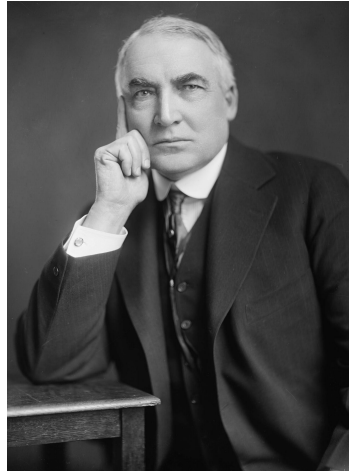
-Only president to serve in

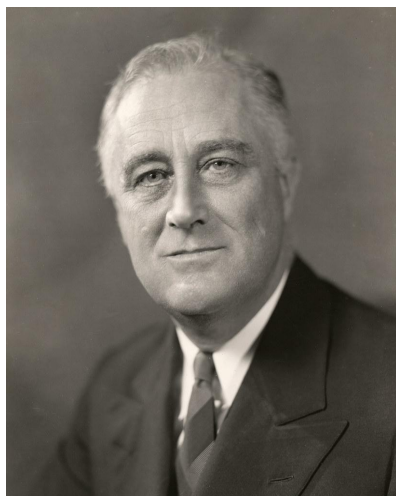
Warren G. Harding

-1923

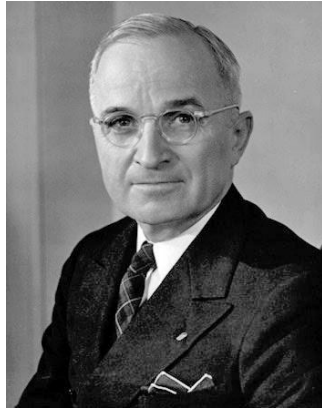


Herbert Hoover
