War with Tarentum

- Tarentum -> part of Magna Graecia
- 2. Makes treaty w/ Rome
 - a. 282 B.C. Romans pass through and violate treaty
 - b. Tarentines attack -> take ships and captives
 - i. Refuse to release captives/pay reparation
 - c. Romans prepare for war






King Pyrrhus of Epirus

- Tarentines ask King Pyrrhus for help (king of Epirus and Macedon)
 - a. Tarentines promise to reinforce his army
- Pyrrhus is an excellent general, trained in hellenistic warfare
 - a. 280 B.C. Pyrrhus arrives with 25k soldiers + 20 elephants
 - b. Wants to set up an empire in Italy

Battle of Heraclea (280 B.C.)

- Battle of Heraclea
 - a. between Pyrrhus and Romans
 - i. Romans vs phalanx, long spears and elephants
 - b. Romans lose 7k, Pyrrhus loses 4k
 - Roman Fabricius sent to discuss ransom for prisoners
 - i. Pyrrhus offers peace and gifts but Fabricius (honorable man) refuses to accept



Appius Claudius

- Pyrrhus sends Cinias to Rome w/ gifts
 - a. Take a kinder stance
- 2. Appius Claudius Caecus
 - a. Blind senator -> condemns
 Romans for negotiating with
 Pyrrhus
 - i. Negotiations = disgrace/dishonor on Rome
 - ii. There will be consequences
 - b. Moved by his speech the senators tell Pyrrhus they will not negotiate until he leaves Italy





April 3rd, 1948:

The Marshall Plan goes into effect when U.S. President Harry S. Truman signed into law George C. Marshall's post-World War II plan to revive the economies of western and southern European countries so as to foster democracy in the region and prevent the spread of communism.
